

QANTAS INTERNATIONAL OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES CARRIAGE OF FIREARMS /AMMUNITION

The movement of Firearms and ammunition through the Qantas network is managed by Group Safety.



FIREARMS/AMMUNITION

Teams and or individual athletes/officials traveling to and from Australia with firearms and or ammunition by Qantas will need to make their own arrangements for the carriage of their firearms and or ammunition from and to their home country with the airline prior to departure for Australia.

Travel to Australia (Individuals)

Persons traveling by Qantas with firearms and or ammunition must be able to produce a letter of approval from Qantas, for carriage of their firearms and or ammunition when checking in.

Passengers must be able to produce:

- A Firearms Licence or its equivalent valid in the country of origin.
- An Import Permit for the destination country.
- An International Visitor Firearm Permit valid in the Australian state of arrival.

Note: As authorities of some transit ports require pre advice and issue approvals, enquiries in this regard should be made to Qantas well in advance of any departure date.

Subject to receipt of a request, provision of the required information, and approval being granted, Qantas will issue a letter of approval for the individual carriage of firearms and or ammunition.

- Passengers full name.
- Type of firearm.
- Flight number/date.
- e-mail address and or fax number.
- Postal Address.
- Amount of ammunition.

Note: The maximum allowance is 5kgs gross per passenger.

- c) Ammunition must be packed in normal clothing suitcase which must be locked.
- d) There must be no indication on the suitcase to identify the contents.
- e) Ammunition must be CHECKED-IN and cannot be carried in the passenger cabin.

Passengers must be able to produce:

- A Firearms Licence or its equivalent valid in the country of origin.
- An Import Permit for the destination country.
- An International Visitor Firearm Permit valid in the Australian state of arrival.

Note: As authorities of some transit ports require pre advice and issue approvals, enquiries in this regard should be made to Qantas well in advance of any departure date.

Subject to receipt of a request by the Team Manager, provision of the required information, and approval being granted, Qantas will issue a letter of approval for the team carriage of firearms and or ammunition. Information required:

- Passengers full name.
- Type of firearm.
- Flight number/date.
- e-mail address and or fax number.
- Postal Address
- Amount of ammunition.

Note: The maximum allowance is 5kgs gross per passenger.

- a) Allowances for more than one passenger CANNOT be combined,
- b) Ammunition must be packed in the original manufacturers packaging (OR BETTER),
- c) Ammunition must be packed in normal clothing suitcase which must be locked.
- d) There must be no indication on the suitcase to identify the contents,
- e) Ammunition must be CHECKED-IN and cannot be carried in the passenger cabin,

QANTAS DOMESTIC OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES CARRIAGE OF FIREARMS /AMMUNITION

The movement of Firearms and ammunition through the Qantas network is managed by Corporate Safety Services. Internal procedures not requested for reasons of security.

Travel within Australia (Individuals)

Passengers with firearms and or ammunition traveling flying with Qantas within Australia must be able to produce a letter of approval from Qantas for carriage of their firearms and or ammunition when checking in

Subject to receipt of a request, provision of the required information, and approval being granted, Qantas will issue a letter of approval for the individual carriage of firearms and or ammunition.

Information required:

- Passengers full name.
- Type of firearm.
- Flight number/date.
- e-mail address and or fax number .
- Postal Address.
- Amount of ammunition.

Note: The maximum allowance is 5kgs gross per passenger.

- a) Allowances for more than one passenger CANNOT be combined.
- b) Ammunition must be packed in the original manufacturers packaging (OR BETTER).
- c) Ammunition must be packed in normal clothing suitcase which must be locked.

Persons traveling by Qantas with firearms and or ammunition must be able to produce a letter of approval from Qantas, for carriage of their firearms and or ammunition when checking in.

Passengers must be able to produce:

- A Firearms Licence or its equivalent valid in the country of origin.
- An Import Permit for the destination country.
- An International Visitor Firearm Permit valid in the Australian state of arrival.
